We are blessed as a Faith Community to celebrate Mass each day of the week.

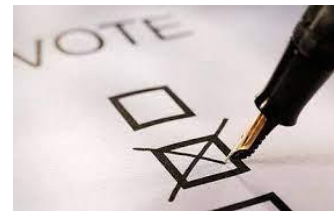
NOTE: Ten daily Mass Missalettes are at the back of the church to be used at Mass. Please do not remove them.

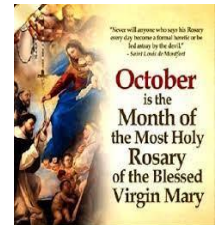
