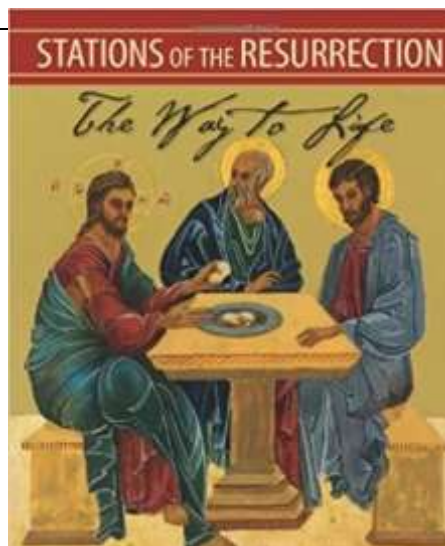

This evening will include Cardinal Collins sharing his thoughts on the election.
