 It is 10 days longer than Lent.

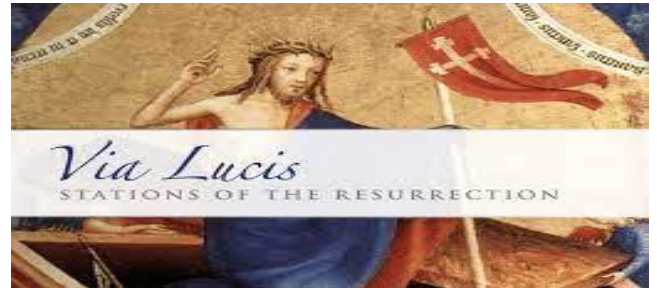


DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY
