### RESTORE HIS HOUSE CAPITAL CAMPAIGN UPDATE

With heartfelt gratitude, we celebrate another remarkable milestone in our Restore His House capital campaign. Through the extraordinary generosity of our parish family and the steadfast commitment of our Knights of Columbus Council, Women's Auxiliary Group and our dedicated Events Coordinating Committee, our campaign has now surpassed **\$354,000** in donations and pledges.
