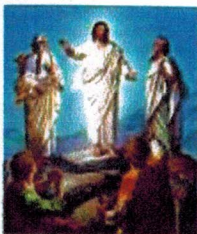

March 2 -3 parishioners are invited to sign a petition addressed to the Honduran Ambassador in Canada asking the Honduran Government to end the persecution of indigenous peoples in Northern Honduras. These communities have been struggling to preserve their land and water since an iron ore mine opened in Carlos Escaleras National Park and poisoned the rivers on which they depend for their livelihoods. “We live every day with the fear of being killed or having one of our children taken away” Juana Zuniga, Committee for the Defense of Common and Public Goods of Tocoa Colon.

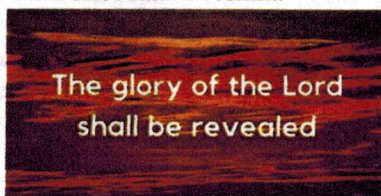

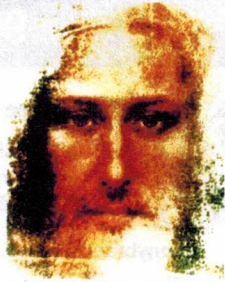
